### Examination Reforms

- 1) A sub-committee was formed to handle the internal test component.
- 2) We have prepared a mark list for internal tests which has columns for students' signatures and tests marks so that it is convenient for the examiner to know which students are absent for the test.
- 3) A time-table that is stress free for students and minimizes cancellation of lectures, is prepared for internal tests.
- 4) Semester End exam mark list has been modified on the lines of University exam mark list & this will be used from 2016-17.
- 5) To accommodate the new ATKT rules we have devised a new ATKT exam form which will help the exam committee to verify such students who may appear for multiple semesters, multiple subjects, internal tests & external exams. This will come into effect from 2016-17.
- 6) A new grade card with water marked additional exam printed across it and \$ symbol against subjects attempted in additional exam was created.
- 7) A Vigilance Squad with Dr. Anil Kumar as the in charge was formed. 32 copy cases were handed over to the Unfair Means Committee.

### Examination Reforms

- 1) We started using software made by Mr.Girish for which the office staff who are a part of examination committee had to be trained
- 2) The examination committee was expanded to accommodate staff from the unaided section (BMS & CS) and then split into two (as some rules related to the marking system are different) under one Examination Convener. This helped in coordination and better functioning of all examination works.
- 3) Semester End exam mark list was modified ( end of 2015-16) on the lines of University exam mark list & brought into effect this year.
- 4) To accommodate the new ATKT rules we had devised a new ATKT exam form (end of 2015-16) which would help the exam committee to verify such students who may appear for multiple semesters, multiple subjects, internal tests & external exams. This was brought into effect this year.
